**EXECUTIVE SUMMARY**

Brewarrina and Goodooga Alcohol Free zones expired 1<sup>st</sup> March 2011. In response to this a meeting was held with Licensees and the NSW Police on 27<sup>th</sup> April 2011.

It was moved by the Brewarrina Accord-

‘That the Alcohol Free Zone previously in place be extended for a further term for 3 years’.

The Local Government Act 1993 does not make any provision for the zones to be renewed. Therefore the following has taken place:

- Meeting with Licensees and Police to determine future Alcohol free zones and their commitment to the Liquor Accord.(27<sup>th</sup> April 2011)
- Consultation process to invite comments on re-establishing the alcohol free zones by advertising in the local paper as well as letters sent to local organisations. (May 27<sup>th</sup> 2011)
- Review of all submissions to be put to council.(15<sup>th</sup> June)
- Council determination on extending the Alcohol Free Zones for another three years from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2011 to 30<sup>th</sup> June 2014. (30<sup>th</sup> June 2011)

**No objections have been received by council during the period up to 15<sup>th</sup> June 2011.**
