

# MINOR FLOOD BULLETIN # 25

## Culgoa River @ Kenebree

Issued: Wednesday, 25 March 2020 at 11.30 AM



### What is happening?

Minor flooding is occurring along the Culgoa River at Kenebree.

### What we are expecting:

Based on the prediction provided by the Bureau of Meteorology;

- The Culgoa River at Kenebree peaked at 5.53 metres on Tuesday with minor flooding.
- The river level is currently at 5.49 metres and falling slowly with minor flooding.
- West Culgoa Road is closed by floodwaters approx 78kms north of Bourke.

### What you need to do:

- Stay up to date with information. Listen to flood warnings and follow advice on how to protect yourself, family and property.
- Do not allow children to play in floodwaters, especially stormwater drains and creeks.
- People working or camping along the Culgoa River should monitor river heights and be prepared to move to higher ground should flooding develop.
- Farmers and landholders are advised to relocate livestock, pumps and machinery to higher ground.
- Motorists are advised to take extreme care as there may be water flowing across causeways and local roads.
- Do not drive through floodwater as floodwaters may be deep, fast flowing and contain debris and is a major cause of flood related deaths.

**Safety is your highest priority - Never walk, drive or play in floodwaters.**
